

Castle Hill School- Phased Opening Plan: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

How our school will look for your child:

Tuesday 2nd June- All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 that have notified the school through the following link may return to school from 9am-3pm by Monday 18th May.

Year 1 Children- Wear Uniform with trainers. Only bring water bottle, PE kit, pencil case. school lunch or packed lunch? Reading books will not be sent home.

9am-Enter the school using the KS2 gate. Only one parent should accompany their child. Please leave siblings at home when it is possible.

On the first day we will ask you to find a coloured spot on the playground. This will then become your allocated spot every day. This will ensure that we are respecting social distancing at all times.

When the bell rings your child must stand still until the teacher asks them to enter the classroom.

The children will spend the day in KS2 classrooms in classes of no more than 15. They will remain in the same group all day and every day to limit cross contamination. Please be aware that this means that your child will not necessarily be taught by their existing class teacher.

The children will be taught a recovery curriculum. This will include:

- Consideration of pupils' mental health and wellbeing
- Assessment of where pupils are in their learning in order to make any necessary adjustments to their curriculum over the coming weeks.

At playtimes children will play in the Key Stage 2 playground. They will not mix at any time with other year groups in the school.

Children may order a packed lunch or bring their own packed lunch to school.

At 3pm the KS2 gates will be open. Parents are asked to stand on their allocated spot in the KS2 playground. Your child will be told to meet you on that spot before leaving the playground.

Teachers will not be available to discuss individual needs at length in the playground. Please ring the school office to make a telephone appointment with Mrs Blake/Mrs Tegg if this is needed. A written School Report will be available at the end of the school year.
