



Castle Hill Primary School has been asked by The Department for Education (DFE) to allow key groups of children back into school as part of a phased approach to the re-opening of schools.

To enable this to happen safely and effectively, our home to school agreement has to be altered.

We (school) will:

- Carry out a thorough risk assessment to enable us to make what we feel is the right decision regarding a planned re-opening.
- Do everything that we can to minimise risk e.g. smaller groupings, different drop off and pick up times, different locations for break and lunchtimes, alteration of classrooms and use of resources. Stay in the same 'Bubbles' wherever possible.
- Ensure that our staff maintain a high level of personal hygiene, in particular with regards to handwashing.
- Ensure that we encourage the children to wash their hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
- Ensure that a member of school staff supervises your child if they are poorly while we are waiting for them to be collected (please note that school staff will need to wear personal protective equipment [PPE]) at this time.

You (parents) will:

- Understand that even with a variety of procedures put in place to limit risk, social distancing is not possible in a primary school.
- Understand that some of the children that will be in school are the children of frontline staff who are in daily contact with Covid19 patients and, as such, have an increased risk of carrying the virus.
- Stick to the allocated group and related drop off and collection times. If your child is in Year 6 and walking home, it is expected that they will maintain social distancing.
- Make sure that your child only brings a pencil case, water bottle, their lunchbox, a healthy snack to school each day (coat if needed) unless directed by your teacher.
- Collect your child immediately if your child shows any symptoms of illness on site and give permission to us to inform other parents by text message if we have a suspected case of Covid.
- Collect your child immediately if your child behaves in a way that puts themselves or others at risk; we will be unable to use normal de-escalation techniques or those involving positive handling.
- Understand that the 'Bubble' your child is in will be sent home for 14 days should there be a positive case of Coronavirus.
- Know that if families are evidenced to be not respecting the current Government social distancing guidance they will forfeit the place at school for their child.
