Dear Parents

All the teachers have been impressed with the quality of work on Seesaw and want to support you. If you haven't uploaded anything recently please do. We have some really creative parents and you are doing a fantastic job. Hopefully, the purpose of PAWS has been understood and in times like these it becomes even more important that we value the education in interacting with our children through baking, gardening, reading games and learning life skills. These stretch far beyond the guidance on a PAWS sheet and give you the confidence to do what is right for you and your children., As well as supporting the year groups back in school we are busy making plans for the whole school return in September. School will be closed over the summer holidays so that teachers all return for the academic year well planned for addressing the needs for all your children.

Results of Risk Assessment.

A formal risk assessment was Carried out today and the following points were considered:

- The number of staff available –

 1 isolating following a minor operation
- The rooms available 8 bubbles in 7 rooms + hall
- The number of keyworker children attending The numbers have risen significantly. We are now FULL and cannot accept any additional Key Workers children. (2 Bubbles)
- The number of children wanting to join the current pubbles

 There is space and adequate teacher/TA's from
 June 22nd-Yr1 (Bubble 2A/2B) and Year 6 (Bubble 3A/3B)
 June 29th for Reception (Bubble 1A/1B)
- Health and Safety procedures have been followed Yes.
 There have been 17 Children/ teachers sent for testing in the county. There has been 1 positive test result. None have been positive here at Castle Hill.
- As a result we are able to offer places to Year 1 and Year 6 children wanting to return to school on 22nd June. Please ensure you have made your decision known to the school office. Please note, there will be no other chance to join the year group before September.

Reception children can join from 29th June. Please share your decision by Friday 26th June at the latest by phoning the office.
