Dear Parents

We have a new revised Risk Assessment that you can view on our website. This takes in consideration that we now are in a Tier 2 area. A reminder of the procedure to follow if there is a suspected Covid case in your household

If someone in your household needs to go for a Covid test you must keep your children at home until the results are returned. If the result is negative your child is welcome back to school immediately. If the test is positive everyone in the household must isolate for fourteen days.

Please ensure you notify the school immediately of the situation.
