Where a pupil at Castle Hill Primary School tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being on site please follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

- Parents only need to inform the school of a positive case where a pupil from Castle Hill Primary School displays symptoms within 48 hours of the confirmed case being on site. Following the report of any positive case, I will send notification to all families in the school so that you are all aware. The children sharing the class of the positive case will be asked to self isolate
