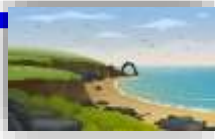

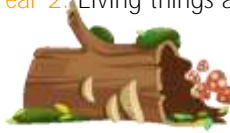
- Explore coasts and coastlines

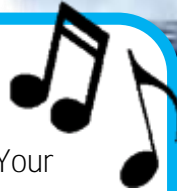
Year 1: Citizenship: Rules and rights, Understanding and practising democracy, Me in my community, Similarities and differences
