Writing During Year 5 children should be able to:

- edit writing to improve its quality and accuracy by adding punctuation from the punctuation pyramid, using a range of connectives and complex sentence constructions and correcting spellings
- use the structures of different poems to write their own work and to convey feelings, reflections or moods in a poem through the careful choice of words and phrases
- write their own playscript, applying conventions learned from reading, including production notes
- write recounts, instructional texts, letters and arguments for a variety of audiences
- use self, peer group and whole class editing to develop and improve writing through the use of vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation. Reading Challenge!
