Y4: measures/area/perimeter/ data and statistics)

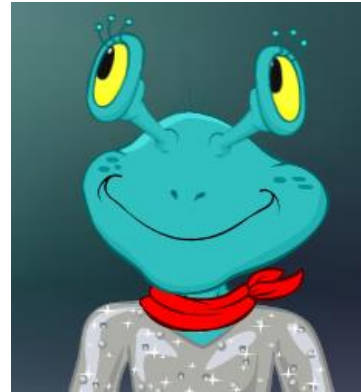
## Art
