Dear Parents

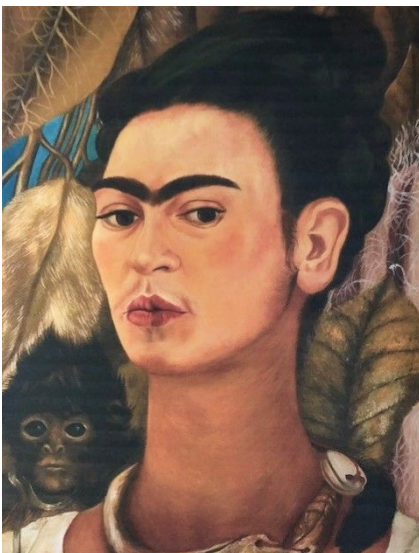
