Floppy's Phonics

We continue the Floppy's Phonics program in Year 1. For every new phoneme introduced your child will bring home a new sheet in their Home Phonics Folder. Please support your child to be a successful reader and writer by reinforcing this phoneme with them at home. This will also ensure that they are successful in the phonics screening test.

Reading

We really value the time and support you give hearing your child read daily.

Your child will be sent home with a new Reading Diary and two reading books at the beginning of the school year. These must be returned to school daily in their book bags. Reading books will be changed every Monday and Friday but please make sure that the Reading Diary and books are in book bags EVERY DAY.

<u>Bookbags</u>

In Year One the children keep their bookbag in their trays. Please do not send in bulky rucksacks which do not fit in these trays or on pegs.

INVITATION

PAWS

At the beginning of every half-term all Castle Hill pupils from Y1-Y6 receive their PAWS folder. The expectation in Year One is that one activity from each of the eight dogs is completed every term.

PAWS is linked to Packtypes. Emotional intelligence or EQ is important to us at Castle Hill. We use the Packtypes tool to help us develop the children's self- awareness.

In Year One we continue to identify and match our behaviours with the Packtype dogs and use our Dojo points to make EQ part of our daily routine. See our school website for more information.

Once an activity is completed the children can keep their PAWS evidence safely in their folders or upload their evidence on Seesaw (see below).

Please ensure the children have their PAWS folders EVERY MONDAY, this helps them practice the skill of meeting deadlines that they need in their further education.



Seesaw

Year 1 will be given an access code to this site to upload PAWS homework evidence too! This will also be checked on a Monday. We use Seesaw as part of our online safety training in Year One and the children enjoy sharing their PAWS work and learning to comment appropriately. You will find your passcode in their PAWS folder. We also use Seesaw to provide you with PAWS support in the first term



P.E is on Fridays.

Please make sure your child always has a full P.E. kit in school including trainers and a tracksuit for outdoor activities.
PLEASE ensure that all your child's uniform is clearly labelled (including P.E. kits). Cardigans and jumpers are easily mislaid without names.
