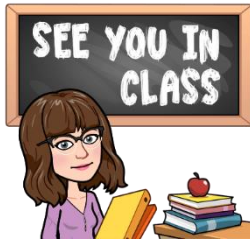


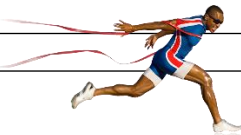
Welcome to Year 4!
