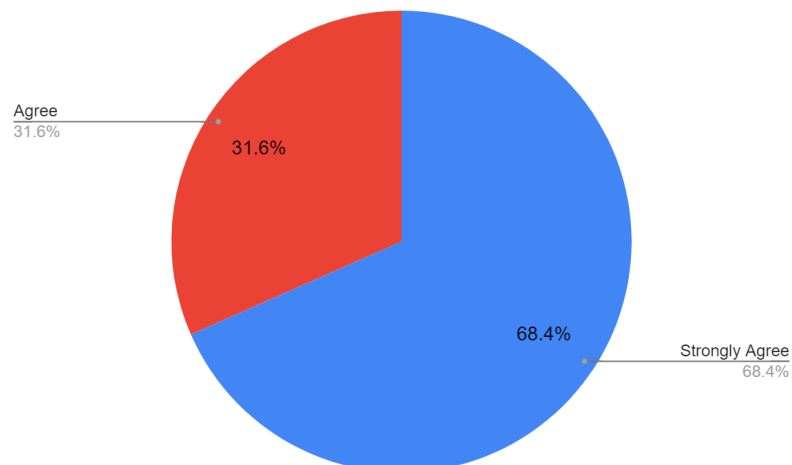
Dear Families,
