Some parents have mentioned that they are not receiving notifications from Edulink, for emails and messages. We have checked our records, and messages are sent to the **first primary contact** each week for newsletters, emails, clubs, and other communications.

Could you please check your phone notification settings? Sometimes notifications can be turned off.

For Apple (iPhone):

1. Go to **Settings**
2. Select **Notifications**
3. Find the **Edulink** app
4. Make sure notifications are turned **ON**

For Android:

1. Go to **Settings**
2. Select **Notifications**
3. Tap **App notifications**
4. Select the **Edulink** app
5. Toggle notifications **ON**
