We need your help!

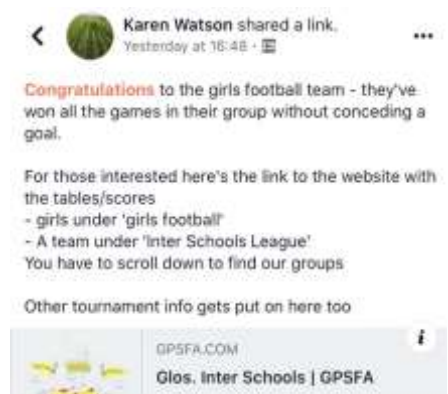
